A Very Busy Month

October is going to be filled with many activities. We start the month with International Walk to School Day on October 5. Please join us at our Open House, Book Fair, and Ice Cream Social on October 6. The Open House and Book Fair are from 6:30-7:30 p.m. and the Ice Cream Social will be in the gym from 7:15-8:00 p.m. We will have our Get Yourself Moving Marathon on October 14, from 1:00-2:15 p.m. Picture retakes will be on October 25. We will have vision and hearing screening on October 24 and 27. We will have a Halloween parade on October 31 at 1:00 p.m. The route is described below. The route is out of the front door of Sullivan, turn right and walk past Ross, walk in a clockwise rotation around the Ross blacktop until they meet up with the sidewalk behind Ross. Fourth grade students will continue on the sidewalk behind Ross and Sullivan and enter Sullivan at the fourth grade back door. Fifth grade students will follow the fourth grade students around the Ross blacktop and sidewalk, but they will enter at the breezeway doors. Parents can view the parade by standing near the sidewalk at the front of Ross and Sullivan, standing around the Ross blacktop, but not on it, or standing on the Sullivan blacktop closest to MacArthur. If it rains we will parade around the gym. We look forward to a wonderful month.

Procedures

Please help us keep interruptions in the classroom to a minimum by making sure that your child knows where he/she is going after school. Also, please remind your child to come with everything that he/she needs every day. We want the students to have as much time as possible to learn without being interrupted.
